We advertise on the reader board, in local papers, and through word of mouth. Since our services are free, even the public schools send many families our way. We tutor right before our Wednesday night club program, so most students stay to participate. Obviously, our club attendance has grown tremendously.

Each tutoring session begins with a prepared evangelistic devotion and prayer sheet. We have seen God honor this "tithing" of our time by multiplied academic benefits. 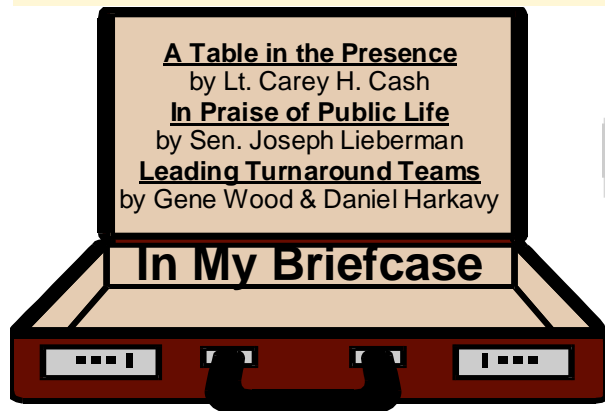
